



Guidance for Visitors with Children



Please understand that WorkForce One is a place of business where people search for jobs to support their families and maintain their homes. Employers often visit our Center to interview prospective employees and frequently there are training classes being conducted in nearby rooms. Therefore it is very important that we maintain a calm, professional atmosphere.

People looking for jobs have the right to do so without being interrupted by children. If you bring children with you when you visit WorkForce One, you are responsible for supervising them and making sure they are well-behaved and quiet so they do not disturb other customers or staff. ***If they misbehave and/or you are not able to keep them quiet we will ask you to take them and leave.***

We have observed children pulling wires out of sockets, climbing on furniture and other similar disruptive behavior. If we observe your children displaying this type of behavior, we will ask you to restrain your child at once. If appropriate behavior is not immediately imposed we will ask you to leave because we do not want children hurt or the equipment damaged.

Clearly it can be difficult to get childcare for a short period of time and we understand you may need to bring children with you to the Center. Your children may stay in the Center as long as they are well-behaved and quiet. Children must be closely supervised and cannot run around or make noise that disturbs others in the opinion of the WorkForce One staff.

If the staff feel your children are disruptive or a danger to themselves, the equipment or others, they are empowered to ask you to leave. The staff and management thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
